I. OBJECT OF AGREEMENT

Object of this agreement is the presented study of the author with the title „ “.

II. ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS

The author assigns the IRO, areal restricted for the durability of the legal copyright, with the exclusive right to duplicate and distribute the study or parts thereof using conditions set by the IRO.

This specifically applies to electronic distribution forms of all kind, but also to print distributions. Electronic distribution forms are all currently known forms of publications, adaptations, duplications and sale of digital data, which means for example on CD-Rom, DVD, e-book, Intra- and Extranet, internet, in all known data format such as Word, xml., pdf. or rtf. etc. as well as databases, from where the data is offered to a third party for export, viewing, download and utilization. For all print- and physical electronic distribution forms, as well as for all circulations without limitation of the quantity in every language.

III. REMUNERATION

Royalty (author's remuneration) for grant of rights will not be paid, all claims are being compensated by the payment of the Sponsorship award.

IV. PLEAD FOR COPYRIGHT RESPECTIVELY COPYRIGHT-ANNOTATION

The IRO obligates itself to display the author as the originator of the study in an appropriate manner.

V. FINAL CLAUSES

As far as this contract delivers no other settlement, the general legal clauses of the right of the Republic of Austria respectively of the European Union are applicable.

Should one or more of those clauses within this contract be or become invalid, because they violate compulsory right, the validation of the rest of the clauses remain unaffected. The contract parties will replace the invalid agreement by a valid one, which complies the most with the intention of the invalid agreement.

The contract parties agree to have the responsible court in Salzburg, should there be any disputes.
