## Requirements

- » Dogs of all ages and test levels, also young dogs
- » Per dog handler only one dog
- » Dog handlers will be used as helpers
- » Proof of all vaccinations according to [IRO vaccination scheme](#) (leptospirosis, parvovirus, distemper, hepatitis, rabies) for the dog; the trainer has to check the dog's vaccination status, in case it does not correspond to the IRO vaccination scheme, the dog is not allowed to participate in the course
- » Valid insurance and required vaccinations for the dog for travelling into and staying in Austria.
- » The taking along and use of means of force are prohibited.
- » The Austrian Animal Welfare Act applies.
- » If a participating bitch is in heat, please inform us during the group allocation on the first day of the course.

The number of participants is limited to 24 search and rescue dog teams.
